SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for the variation of premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003.

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to:

1. Grant the application and
2. Add the condition as volunteered by the Applicant of the premises licence as set out below:-
 - a. Between the hours of 11pm and 8am all alcohol within the trading area (for the avoidance of doubt this does not include the display area behind the counter) is to be kept behind shutters/screens/grills.
 - b. That Condition 5 of Annex 2 of the current licence be retained.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision.
