Dear Lorna,

I am writing to give my permission to use the photographs and to publish them as part of the agenda on the Web.

I wish to question Gilass Vibes plans with some of the pictures submitted. The shop has recently started storing scooters and bikes in one part of the shop ( photos 1-3). I am concerned about this as scooters can be self combustable and this seems dangerous.

The photos of the back premises showing nails sticking out is dangerous. This is a health and safety issue (photo 5, 8, 9 all show angles of the back premises) It also shows what looks like a vent that has been fitted very crudely on this back premise.

The photos showing the back door shows that the door is old and suggests it is not fit for purpose. Does this door serve as an emergency safety exit ? This door is padlocked. This is suggested in the plan. But does it serve a double function of being in use by customers that wish to smoke outside ? ( see photo 4 and 7).

One photo shows the proximity of [REDACTED] door number [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Gilass Vibes back door ( photo 4).

I have taken a picture of my window near my front door. This is a security risk if customers are coming in and out of Gilass Vibes, a possible thief could break the window and get into my flat.

As I have already stated in my letter of objection the public alleyway is fraught with lots of different types of anti social behaviour, eg drug taking, drug selling, street drinking, urination, defecation, dumped rubbish and fly tipping and homeless sleeping.
