SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for the grant of a premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 for the sale by retail of alcohol - off the Premises only ("the Application")

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to:

1. Grant the application in part by modifying the proposed hours for the delivery of the sale of alcohol off the Premises as follows

Monday- Sunday 06:00-24:00

2. The licence is subject to any mandatory conditions
3. Modify the conditions of the licence volunteered by the Applicant in the operating schedule, by altering or omitting or adding them

4. Imposing two conditions at the Licence as suggested at the hearing by the Applicant regarding delivery times and providing a telephone number to local residents.

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant is unhappy with the decision, they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision

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
