SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003.

- b) Further to add a condition to ensure that the telephone number of the Licence Holder or responsible member of staff is made visible from the highway for members of the public to lodge complaints.

If any of the parties is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision.
