SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for the grant of a new premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 for the following: performance of a play (indoors) , exhibition of a film (indoors), performance of live music (indoors), playing of recorded music (indoors) , performance of dance (indoors), provision of late night refreshment (indoors) , sale of alcohol on the Premises only (“the Application”).

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to:

Reject the whole application.
