SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Application")

Grant the application in part – modifying the proposed hours for the exhibition of film from 3pm until 7pm, Thursday to Friday.

In respect of the hours for the sale of alcohol to be permitted between 10am to 22.30pm between Thursday and Saturday and to modify the hours for Sunday to be limited from 10am to 3pm.

If any of the parties is unhappy with the decision, they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision
