## **SUMMARY OF DECISION**

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence for the sale of alcohol both on and off the Premises under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Application").

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives:

- 1. To grant the application by imposing the licensable hours proposed by the Licensing Department and agreed by the Applicant Mondays to Sundays 11:00 to 22:30
- Opening Hours of the Premises are as follows;
  Mondays to Sundays 07:00 to 23:00
- 3. To impose conditions proposed by the Police and agreed by the Applicant

4. To impose conditions about litter, further conditions regarding the training of staff, conditions regulating the sale of alcohol on the Premises' website

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If any party is unhappy with the decision, they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision.
