## SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence application for a proposed convenience store/mini supermarket, for the sale of alcohol off the premises only under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Application").

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

- 1. Grant the application
- 2. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Police and agreed by the Applicant and the following conditions added by the Committee
- Single cans or bottles of beer or cider shall not be sold.
- Deliveries for customer orders shall be made to a building which is used for residential and/or work purposes. Deliveries shall not be made to outdoor spaces.

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

If the Applicant is unhappy with the decision, they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision.
