#### SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence for the sale of alcohol on the premises only under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Application").

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

1. Grant the Application as follows:

The premises licence will end on 31st January 2028

2. The sale of alcohol on the premises only

Sunday to Wednesday 10:00 to 22:30 hours Thursday to Saturday 10:00 to 22:45 hours

3. The opening hours of the premises ae as follows:

Mondays to Sundays from 10:00 to 23:00

- 4. The licence is subject to any mandatory conditions.
- 5. The licence is subject to the conditions volunteered by the Applicant in the operating schedule.

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision, they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence for the sale of alcohol off the premises only under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Application").

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to:

1. Grant the Application as follows:

Sale of alcohol off the Premises Mondays to Sundays from 07:00 to 23:00

2. The opening hours of the premises are as follows:

Mondays to Sundays from 06:00 to 23:00

3. The licence is subject to any mandatory conditions.

- 4. The licence is subject to the conditions volunteered by the Applicant in the operating schedule as amended by the Committee ( the CTTV condition).
- 5. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Police and agreed by the Applicant. The proposed condition 1 by the Police will be replaced with the following condition:
  - "Strong beer (including lager, stout, ale etc) and cider above 5.5% ABV shall not be sold except for any brand agreed by a Metropolitan Police Licensing Officer"
- 6. The licence is subject an additional condition proposed by the Applicant at the hearing as follows:

"No deliveries of alcohol shall take place from the Premises after 20:00".

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision, they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision
