## SUMMARY OF DECISION

### **GROUND FLOOR, 156 MUNSTER ROAD, LONDON, SW6 5RA (“THE PREMISES”)**

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence for the sale of alcohol off the premises under the Licensing Act 2003 (“the Application”).

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

1. Grant the Application in part as follows:  
The sale of alcohol off the premises only  
Mondays to Sundays 10:00 to 22:00
2. The opening hours of the premises are:  
Mondays to Saturdays between the hours of 08:00 to 23:00.  
Sundays between the hours of 08:00 to 22:00
3. The licence is subject to any mandatory conditions

4. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Police and agreed by the Applicant

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision
