SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence for the sale of alcohol on the Premises, the performance of live music outdoors only, the playing of recorded music outdoors only, the performance of dance outdoors only, entertainment similar to music or dance outdoors only under the Licensing Act 2003 (“the Application”).

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to:

1. To grant the Application for one year Only; for one weekend either in August or September as follows:

The Performance of Live Music – Outdoors Only
Saturdays and Sundays 12:00 to 20:00

The Playing of Recorded Music – Outdoors Only
Saturdays and Sundays 12:00 to 20:00

The Performance of Dance – Outdoors Only
Saturdays and Sundays 12:00 to 20:00

Entertainment similar to Music or Dance - Outdoors Only
Saturdays and Sundays 12:00 to 20:00

The Sale of Alcohol - On the Premises Only
Saturdays and Sundays 12:00 to 20:00

2. The opening hours of the premises are as follows:

Saturdays and Sundays 12:00 to 20:30

3. The licence is subject to any mandatory conditions
4. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Police and Environmental Protection Team as agreed by the Applicant
5. The licence is subject to five conditions imposed by the Committee as follows;
 1. the Applicant to work with residents to finalise the layout of the Premises,
 2. A phone number to be displayed at the Premises or on the website so residents can lodge complaints
 3. A responsible member of staff shall carry out proactive litter patrols inside and outside the premises during the premises' opening hours and specifically at the end of trading hours to ensure that there is no litter associated with the premises in the premises and in the immediate vicinity and any such litter found shall be collected and returned to the premises for disposal with the premises' normal waste / refuse collection.
 4. A written record of proactive external litter patrols shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days from the date of the last entry in the record and this record shall be available for inspection on request by authorised officers of the Licensing Authority at all times the premises are open.
 5. To increase the number of stewards and security personnel if recommended during the meetings with residents, SAG or in the management plan

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons, and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision
