## SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application to vary the hours for the sale of alcohol off the premises under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Application").

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

1. Grant the application as follows;

Sale of Alcohol - Off the Premises

Monday to Sunday 07:00 - 23:00

2. Add the following conditions to the existing licence

- The sale of alcohol between the hours of 7am and 9am shall be by delivery only
- Deliveries shall be made to a building which is used for residential and/or work purposes. Deliveries shall not be made to outdoor spaces.

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision.
