SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence for the following licensable activities under the Licensing Act 2003 (“the Application”).

- Plays (Indoors Only),
- Films (Indoors Only),
- Live Music (Indoors Only),
- Recorded Music Indoors Only),
- Dance (Indoors Only),
- Anything Similar to Music or Dance (Indoors Only),
- Late Night Refreshment (Indoors Only),

- Sale of Alcohol (Both on and Off the Premises).

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

1. Grant the Application as follows:

Plays, Films, Live Music, Recorded Music, Dance, Anything similar to music or dance - Indoors Only

Mondays to Sundays - 09:30 to 00:30

Late Night Refreshment - Indoors Only

Mondays to Sundays - 23:00 to 00:30

The Sale of Alcohol - On the Premises

Mondays to Sundays - 09:30 to 00:30

2. The opening hours of the premises are

Mondays to Sundays - 09:00 to 01:00

3. The licence is subject to any mandatory conditions updated on 28th January 2025
4. The licence is subject to the conditions updated on 28th January 2025 volunteered by the Applicant in the operating schedule as amended by the Committee

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision
