SUMMARY OF DECISION

ST PAULS GREEN – PARK, ST PAULS GREEN, HAMMERSMITH BRIDGE ROAD, LONDON

The Committee has considered an application for the variation of a premises licence to remove the time limited condition of the licence, vary the days and times for the sale of alcohol on the premises, the performance of live music outdoors only, the playing of recorded music outdoors only, and add the licensable activities of the performance of dance outdoors only and the provision of films outdoors only to the existing Premises Licence under the Licensing Act 2003 (“the Application”).

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

1. To grant the variation to Licence in full

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee’s full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision issued, they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision
