SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence for the supply of alcohol on the premises and for Late Night Refreshment (Indoors and Outdoors) under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Application").

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

1. Grant the Application as follows:

Supply of Alcohol (Off the Premises):

Monday to Sunday 11:00 to 23:00

Late Night Refreshment (Indoors and Outdoors):

Monday to Sunday 23:00 to 00:00*

*Deliveries only from 00:00 to 01:00

2. The opening hours of the Premises are as follows:-

Monday to Sunday: 11:00 to 01:00

- 3. The Licence is subject to any mandatory conditions
- 4. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Applicant as amended by the Committee.
- 5. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Police and agreed by the Applicant
- 6. The Licence is subject to the following additional conditions proposed by the Committee
- 1. The Premises shall use electric bikes only for deliveries after 11pm

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision.
