SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a variation of the existing premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 (“the Application”) to extend the terminal hours for the existing licensable activities Thursdays to 01:00 and Fridays and Saturdays to 02:00 and to amend the hours the Premises is opened to the public.

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to grant the application in full. The Committee agreed to replace the existing conditions 9, 13, 14, 17, 18 with the conditions proposed by the Police as agreed by the Applicant. The Committee agreed to add to the existing Licence 11 additional conditions proposed by the Police and agreed by the Applicant.

The Committee decided to impose a condition for Ask for Angela scheme to be implemented at the Premises.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the Licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision.
