SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for the grant of a new premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 for the sale of alcohol off the Premises ("the Application")

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

1. Grant the Application as follows:

Sale of Alcohol (Off the Premises) Monday to Sunday: 07:00 to 23:00

2. The opening hours of the Premises are as follows:-Monday to Sunday: 00:00 to 00:00

- 3. The licence is subject to any mandatory conditions.
- 4. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Applicant as amended by the Committee

Condition 3 amended by the Committee as follows:

The system will incorporate a recording facility, and any recording will be retained and stored in a suitable and secure manner for a minimum of 30 days and will be made available, subject to compliance with Data Protection legislation, to the Police or authorised officers of the Licensing Authority for inspection on request

- 5. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Police and agreed by the Applicant
- 6. The Licence is subject to the additional conditions imposed by the Committee
- 1. A responsible member of staff shall organise and accommodate a meeting to discuss the operation of the Premises with the Barclays Road Residents' Association and a representative of the residents of Valour House in the area within 6 months of opening the premises. The meeting shall be advertised at least 14 days before its due date by letter or email to Barclay Road Residents' Associations and the representative of the residents of Valour House as well as to the Licensing Authority
- 2. A telephone number of the Premises shall be displayed so that it is visible for the public to contact store management.

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision, they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision
