SUMMARY OF DECISION

The Committee has considered an application for a new premises licence for the following licensable activities:

- The Sale of Alcohol (On and Off the Premises)
- The Playing of Recorded Music (Indoors Only)
- Late Night Refreshment (Indoors and Outdoors)

under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Application").

In summary, the Committee has decided, after taking into account all of the individual circumstances of this case and the promotion of the four licensing objectives to

1. Grant the Application as follows:

The Sale of Alcohol (On and Off the Premises)

Sunday to Thursday: 11:00 to 00:00

Friday and Saturday: 11:00 to 00:30

The Playing of Recorded Music (Indoors Only)

Sunday to Thursday: 08:00 to 00:30

Friday and Saturday: 08:00 to 01:00

Late Night Refreshment (Indoors and Outdoors)

Sunday to Thursday: 23:00 to 00:00

Friday and Saturday: 23:00 to 00:30

2. The opening hours of the Premises are as follows:-

Sunday to Thursday: 08:00 to 00:30

Fridays and Saturday: 08:00 to 01:00

3. The licence is subject to any mandatory conditions.
4. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Applicant as amended by the Committee
5. The licence is subject to the conditions proposed by the Police and agreed by the Applicant

This licence becomes operational with immediate effect. If problems are experienced, then an application for a review of the premises licence can be made.

A copy of this Committee's full decision including its reasons and the full text of the conditions added to the licence will be sent to the parties forthwith.

If the Applicant or any person who has made a relevant representation is unhappy with the decision they are entitled to appeal to the magistrates' court within 21 days from the date of notification of the full decision.
