

NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF A KEY DECISION AND THE INTENTION TO CONDUCT BUSINESS IN PRIVATE

In accordance with paragraph 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, the Cabinet hereby gives notice of a Key Decision which it intends to consider at its next meeting on 12 November 2012.

The Cabinet also gives notice in accordance with paragraph 5 of the above Regulations that it intends to meet in private after its public meeting to consider part of this Key Decision which will contain confidential or exempt information. The private meeting of the Cabinet is open only to Members of the Cabinet, other Councillors and Council officers.

Any person is able to make representations to the Cabinet if he/she believes the decision should instead be made in the public Cabinet meeting. Both your representations and the Executive's response will be published on the Council's website at least 5 working days before the Cabinet meeting.

This decision may be called in by Councillors. If a decision is called in, it will not be capable of implementation until a final decision is made.
