<p>APPROVAL TO TERMINATE THE ST MUNGO'S WOOD LANE SUPPORTED ACCOMMODATION CONTRACT BEFORE THE END OF THE CONTRACT</p> <p>This report is currently exempt from disclosure on the grounds that they relate to the financial or business affairs of a particular person (including the authority holding that information) under paragraph 3 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972, and in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.</p> <p>This report requests the approval to terminate the St Mungo's Wood Lane Supported Housing contract before the contract ends on 31 March 2019. The contract includes a "no-fault" break clause.</p> <p><u>Reasons for Urgency:</u></p> <p>A Leader's Urgency Decision is recommended so the proposed service changes can be implemented at the earliest opportunity to maximise savings and speed up identifying alternative housing and support options for the existing residents.
