



Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the licensing objectives

a) General- all four licensing objectives (b,c,d and e)

Zero tolerance to anti-social behaviour and ensuring no harm to children.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- 1. A tamper proof CCTV system shall be installed at the locations marked, "CCTV Position" on the plan of the premises and shall be used to record during all hours that a licensable activity takes place on the premises.
- 2. The CCTV equipment shall be maintained in good working order in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 3. The images recorded by the CCTV system shall be retained in unedited form for a period of not less than 31 days.
- 4. The images recorded by the CCTV system shall be made available to authorised officer and/or police within 24 hours of any request.
- 5. Effective and responsible management of the premises.
- 6. Training and supervision of staff.
- 7. Every incident of crime or disorder in the premises shall be reported to the police by the Designated Premises Supervisor or a nominated member of staff.
- 8. The Designated Premises Supervisor and all members of staff shall en-sure that all lawful and reasonable instructions and/or directions given by the police are complied with.
- 9. Acceptable age at verification documents will only be Proof of Age with the "pass" hologram, photo UK driving licence, military ID, passport tor European Union Member State ID card with photo.
- Warnings will be displayed on the premises to remind customers that any purchase of alcohol must be made by someone over 18.
- c) Public safety

- 1. Before the premises are opened for the purposes authorised by the licence an inspection shall be carried out to ensure that the premises are safe for use.
- 2. Emergency light and smoke detector system shall be installed at the locations marked, "emergency light" and "smoke detector" on the plan of the premises.
- 3. Emergency Lighting will be tested in accordance with BS 5266 Part 1, 1999 Emergency Lighting. The results of the tests will be recorded in a logbook.
- 4. The fire alarm detection system will be tested in accordance with BS 5839 Part 1 2002 Fire Detection and Fire Alarm Systems for buildings. The results of the tests will be recorded in a logbook.
- 5. All exits and escape routes to those exits (including external escape routes) from the premises shall be clearly marked, maintained in good repair, correct working order and kept free from all obstructions when the public are on the premises.
- 6. Firefighting equipment shall be provided throughout the premises at suit-able locations and be appropriate to the risk to comply with BS 5306 Part 8, Selection and Installation of Portable Fire Extinguishers.
- 7. Firefighting equipment shall be examined regularly by the manufacturer or other competent person and maintained and tested in accordance with BS 5306 Part 3, 2000.
- 8. All members of staff will be familiar with the operation of the firefighting equipment.
- 9. All staff shall be instructed and trained to ensure that they understand the fire precaution measures in the premises and the procedure and action to be taken in the event of fire
- 10. The electrical installation will be inspected annually.
- 11. Any gas boiler, calorifier or other gas appliance will be tested on a regu-lar basis.

Health and safety risk assessments to be undertaken and staff shall be trained.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- 1. There shall be displayed at the entrance to the premises a sign, which is clearly visible to members of the public visiting the premises containing details of the trading hours under the premises licence.
- 2. There shall be displayed at the entrance to the premises a sign, which is clearly visible to members of the public visiting the premises, requesting the customers to respect the neighbours surrounding the premises and to behave in an orderly and courteous manner.
- 3. All staff shall be instructed and trained to ensure customers are discouraged from congregating outside the premises.
- 4. The premises will only be open to the public between the hours as set in this application.
- 5. All staff shall be instructed and trained to ensure no deliveries of stock are made to the premises between 22:00 and 08:00 on any day.
- 6. All staff shall be instructed and trained to ensure that external illumination signs are switched off when the premises are closed for licensable activities.
- 7. All staff shall be instructed and trained to ensure the sale or supply of alcohol is prohibited to any person who is intoxicated.
- e) The protection of children from harm
- 1. There shall be in place for the premises a written policy to prevent the sale or supply of alcohol to persons under 18 years of age. That policy shall require any person who appears to be under the age of 18 years to produce a recognised proof of age card accredited under the Proof of Age Standards Scheme (PASS), a citizen card supported by the Home Office, a photo driving licence, a passport or official HM Forces or EU ID card bearing photo and date of birth.
- 2. A notice or notices shall be displayed in and at the entrance to the premises where they can be clearly seen and read and shall indicate that it is unlawful for persons under 18 to purchase alcohol or for any person to purchase alcohol on behalf of a person under 18 years of age.
