

APPENDIX A

Cross reference section C Public Safety, D The Prevention of Public Nuisance, E The Protection of Children from Harm.

- CCTV shall be in operation at the premises. All images shall be stored for a minimum of 31 days
- A staff member that is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times that the premises are open to the public. This staff member will be able to show police or authorised officers of the licensing authority recent data footage with a minimum of delay when requested.
- CCTV shall be working and recording correctly at all times
- At least one member of staff on duty whilst this licence is being used shall be trained in the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 in terms of the licensing objectives, offences committed under the Act and conditions of the Premises Licence.
- Non-alcoholic beverages, including tap water, shall be available to customers throughout the permitted hours for sale of alcohol.
- Alcohol shall only be sold from the demarcated area
- Alcohol sold from our premises shall not be drunk outside of our premises
- An incident record shall be maintained by the Licence Holder / DPS / Manager that details incidents including refused sales, any issues of disorder, faults in the CCTV system as a minimum.
- The premises shall operate a Challenge 25 restricted sales policy and shall display appropriate signage advising customers of this initiative.
- All staff shall be trained in the Proof of Age policy and how to identify acceptable means of identification. This will include the assessment of age; how and when to challenge for proof of age; acceptable proof of age and how to check; and recording refusals.
- All alcohol shall be stored and displayed behind the service counter
- All alcohol units shall be closed and secured/locked when left unattended
- Where customers are permitted to smoke immediately outside the premises, smoking bins/ashtrays/receptacles shall be provided
- The use of the outside area shall be limited to the Clip 'n Climb Chelsea premises and shall not include any part of the public highway
- External lighting for the premises shall be turned off after the premises are closed to the public
- Signage shall be displayed reminding customers that there are residents living nearby and instructing them to respect our neighbours and behave accordingly
- The Premises Licence Holder must ensure that any Guidance issued by the Government and the Local Authority is adhered to as far as it impacts upon the Licensing Objectives, provided that the advice is relevant, reasonable and has been brought to the Licence Holder's attention by the Local Authority in writing.
- The premises shall operate a zero tolerance policy to drug use and posters shall be prominently displayed to this effect.
