

- Elected on March 23rd through borough wide elections supported by Electoral Services, they have:
 - completed inductions
 - attended events and functions with the Mayor and UK Youth Parliament
 - chaired Youth Council meetings
 - attended Full Council on 13th July to share an outline of their manifesto.
- Aims:
- reach out and capture views of ALL young people
- share information in a way that is accessible and meaningful
- Refugee Focus:
 - Ben, the Youth Mayor is of Afghan origin and wants to be a supportive role model to the young Afghan refugees
 - Regular visits planned to build a relationship and capture their views.
 - Considering a project to support Ukrainian refugees.
