I am writing in connection with a visit to the above premises on the 11 March 2021 carried out by the Noise and Nuisance Team. The purpose of visit was to ensure that the premises were trading in accordance with the current public health regulations and that the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 were being complied with.

The Council as the Licensing Authority are the relevant authority for the issuing of Premises Licences (in accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003). I would, therefore, bring to your attention the following incident which was observed on 11 March 2021 which constitute as a contravention of the legislation. This incident is listed on the enclosed schedule and you will need to ensure that appropriate steps be taken to remedy the situation immediately.

**Please note that a failure to comply with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and associated regulations is an offence. As such, the Council has decided to issue this warning letter and may consider further formal action.**

## **Schedule of Contraventions**

### **Licensing Act 2003**

**Lebanese Taverna Express, 40 Fulham Palace Road London W6 9PH**

#### **Section 136 - unauthorised licensable activities**

- (1) This section applies whenever premises in respect of which a premises licence has effect are being used for one or more licensable activities authorised by the licence.
- (2) It is an offence to carry on or attempt to carry on a licensable activity on or from any premises otherwise than under or in accordance with the authorisation provided by a premises licence.
- (3) It is also an offence to breach and terms and conditions included in such licence including any relating to hours during which the licensable activities may take place.

#### **The Licensing Authority have been made aware of the following –**

- That on Thursday, 11 March 2021, officers from the Noise and Nuisance team witnessed staff at the premises providing hot food to customers at approximately 02:20.

*Please be aware that the provision of hot food and drinks at 02:20 is a breach of your premises licence and the current public health regulations.*

#### **Required action –**

The premises benefits from a premises licence which is subject to terms and conditions. The trading hours specified on the current licence are as follows:

Licence Number: 2005/05015/LAPR

- Sale of Alcohol  
Monday to Sunday: 12:00 until 02:00
- Late Night Refreshment  
Monday to Sunday: 23:00 until 02:00

All terms and conditions of the premises licence must be complied with at all times. Please refer to your licence for terms and conditions. The licence summary or a certified copy, must be displayed at the premises at all times. The licence holders (Mr Fariborz Ranjbar Larijani & Mr Avtar Singh Mann) must ensure that all staff are aware of the permitted activities, days, times and conditions of the premises licence in order to ensure no further unauthorised licensable activities are observed at a future date.

**Carrying out unauthorised licensable activities is a criminal offence under Section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003 in which upon conviction the maximum sentence is an unlimited fine or a prison sentence not exceeding six months, or both (for each individual offence).**
