Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

1. Mandatory Condition

1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—

(a) a holographic mark, or

(b) an ultraviolet feature.

2. Mandatory Condition

1.A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price. 2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1-

(a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979; (b)"permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula—

where-

 $\mathsf{P} = \mathsf{D} + (\mathsf{D} \times \mathsf{V})$

(i) P is the permitted price,(ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were

charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and

(iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
(c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—

(i) the holder of the premises licence,

(ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or

(iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

(d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

(e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.

3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.

4(1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

3. Mandatory Condition

(1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-

(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

(2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

4. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied in an open container or be consumed in the licensed premises.

5. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied.

Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

6. The premises shall not sell nor offer for sale the following products in excess of 5.5% alcohol by volume: beer; lager; stout; ale and cider.

7. All staff involved in the sale of alcohol at the premises shall be required to take and pass a nation accredited licensing qualification.

8. The premises licence holder shall operate a refusals book which shall be paginated and made available for inspections by authorised authorities.

9. The premise shall use a till operation system which provide an ID confirmation prompt when alcohol is scanned.

10. The premises shall operate a Challenge 25 policy. Only photographic ID such as British Driving Licence, a Current Passport or a PASS ID card shall be treated as acceptable forms of identification.

11. All staff shall be trained in the Proof of Age policy and how to identify acceptable means of identification.

12. Appropriate signage shall be displayed in a prominent position, informing customer they are being recorded on CCTV.

13. CCTV covering areas inside and outside of the premises should be installed and maintained to Police recommendations with properly maintained log arrangements. All images shall be stored for a minimum of 31 days.

14. A staff member forms the premises that is conversant with the operations of the CCTV system shall always be on the premises at all times that the premises are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show Police or authorised local authority officers recent data footage with the minimum of delay when requested. This data or footage reproduction should be almost instantaneous
