

## Appendix 1 – Proposed Area and Restrictions

### 1. Proposed restrictions of PSPO:

1	A person in charge of a dog is prohibited from taking the dog onto or permitting the dog to enter or to remain on land within the restricted area referred to in <b>Schedule 1</b> .
2	A person in charge of a dog, at any time, must keep the dog on a lead in the restricted area detailed in <b>Schedule 2</b> of this Order.
3	A person in charge of a dog, at any time, must put and keep the dog on a lead when directed to do so in the restricted area detailed in <b>Schedule 3</b> of this Order.
4	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) A person in charge of more than one dog, at any time, must not take more than 4 dogs in the restricted area detailed in <b>Schedule 4</b> of this Order.</li><li>2) A person must not walk with other dog walkers when the combined number of dogs exceeds 4 in the restricted area detailed in <b>Schedule 4</b> of this Order.</li></ol>
5	If a dog defecates at any time on land in the restricted area detailed in <b>Schedule 5</b> of this Order and the person who is in charge of the dog at the time fails to remove the faeces from the land forthwith, that person shall be guilty of an offence.
6	A person in charge of a dog, at any time, must be able to produce a poop scoop and/or disposable bags which would be used to remove the faeces from the land on the request of an authorised officer and do so in the restricted area detailed in <b>Schedule 6</b> of this Order.
	<p>Exemptions:</p> <p>Nothing in Schedule 1, 5 &amp; 6 applies to a Disabled person who uses a dog in which they rely upon for assistance.</p> <p>Dogs preferably should be trained by a member of Assistance Dogs UK or any other registered charity whose activities include the training of assistance dogs.</p> <p>Some member organisations can be found here: <a href="http://www.assistedogs.org.uk">Find an Assistance Dog Charity - ADUK (assistedogs.org.uk)</a></p>

### 2. Schedule 1 - Exclusion areas:

3. The following areas of land which are open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access (with or without payment) within the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham —
  - All children's play areas

- All fenced sporting areas
- All fenced war memorial areas
- All no dog areas within the following parks and open spaces. These are clarified below:
  - All grounds of Fulham Palace
  - Bishops Park - Fenced picnic area & pond area
  - Cathnor Park – Dog exclusion zone
  - Eel Brook Common - Fenced picnic area & fenced flower garden
  - Furnivall Gardens - Walled garden
  - Godolphin Road Open Space - Pond area
  - Gwendwr Gardens
  - Ravenscourt Park - Picnic area, walled garden, fenced area around the lake, & wildlife area
  - Rowberry Mead Open Space
  - St Paul's Garden - Fenced picnic area
  - South Park - Pond area
  - Vicarage Gardens
  - Wendell Park - School zone

#### 4. **Schedule 2 - Dogs on Leads areas:**

5. The following areas of land which are open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access (with or without payment) within the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham —

- All cemeteries and churchyards under the administrative control of the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham. This includes those outside of the geographical boundaries of the borough shown below:
  - Mortlake Cemetery
  - North Sheen Cemetery
- All Wildlife Conservation Areas:
  - Bishop's Park Wildlife Area
  - Wormwood Scrubs Wildlife Areas
- All Café/Tea Houses
- All Outdoor Gyms
- The following areas within parks and open spaces:
  - Bayonne Road Open Space
  - Bishops Park - Event area & moat garden
  - Brook Green - Picnic area
  - Cathnor Park - Forest school
  - Frank Banfield Park - Community garden
  - Hammersmith Park - Japanese garden
  - Hurlingham Park – Rose garden
  - Loris Gardens
  - Marcus Garvey Area - Forest school
  - Normand Park - Community garden & bowling green garden
  - Shepherd's Bush Green – former toilet block area
  - Sir William Powell Almshouses

- South Park - Community centre & market garden
- St Paul's Garden - Forest school
- Wendell Park - Picnic area
- Westcroft Square
- William Parnell Park - Community garden
- Wormwood Scrubs - Forest schools

**6. Schedule 3, 4, 5, & 6 - Leads on leads as directed, Specified maximum, Fouling, Clean-up scoop and/or bag requirement areas:**

7. All areas of land which are open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access (with or without payment) within the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham.
