## YOUR AGE



Nursery - 6 children

44.5% of you in Y2 achieved at least the expected standard in reading, writing and maths



In Y6 75% of you achieved the expected standard in reading and writing and 50% of you achieved the expected standard in maths

50% of you on a GCSE pathway achieved grade 5 or above in English and Maths GCSE's

In Y13 6 of you completed your studies at L3 and 5 of you are going to University in September!







## This year we have...

### TRAINING

Delivered 11 training sessions to your teachers and foster carers to help them understand how best to help you.

Launched an 'Attachment Aware Schools' programme to make school a better place for everyone.

### ENRICHMENT

Run a wide range of enrichment activities including 3 residentials and 3 week long projects.

Supported you to join after school clubs and activities to broaden your interests and make friends.

### POST 16 SUPPORT

Worked with University College London to improve outcomes for care experienced young people by designing a pre-employability programme and work experience offer.



## Next year we want to...

### YOUR VOICE

Develop a toolkit so that we can make sure your voice is stronger in your Personal Education Plan.

### LEARNING SUPPORT

Offer a weekly homework support group where you can get help with your studies.

### TRAINING

Increase our training offer to at least 18 sessions to reach more professionals and cover more areas.

Recruit at least 5 new schools to the "Attachment Aware Schools' programme."

### ENRICHMENT

Continue to offer a calendar of wide ranging enrichment opportunities.

Improve access to enrichment opportunities for any of you with special educational needs

### POST 16 SUPPORT

Run weekly drop in support sessions and at least 4 open events with different employers at our Hub.
