RE: New Premises Licence Application – Pepe’s Piri Piri, 179 King Street – 2024/00145

Please see the below the amendments (highlighted in red) to the timings of licensable activity applied for and the police proposed conditions (also highlighted in red) in relation to the above application. All amendments and conditions have been agreed with the applicant in support of the licensing objective in the Prevention of Crime and Disorder.

Amended Timings:

Late Night Refreshment provided indoors;

Sunday to Thursday 23:00 – 00:00

Friday and Saturday 23:00 – 01:00

Late Night Refreshment provided outdoors;

Sunday to Saturday 23:00 – 04:00

Police Proposed Conditions – Agreed with applicant

1. High Definition CCTV shall be installed, operated and maintained, at all times that the premises are open for licensable activities and;

- shall be checked every two weeks to ensure that the system is working properly and that the date and time are correct. A record of these checks, showing the date and name of the person checking, shall be kept and made available to Police or authorised Council officers on request
- one camera will show a close-up of the entrance to the premises, to capture a clear, full length image of anyone entering.
- shall cover any internal or external area of the premises where licensable activities take place.
- recordings shall be in real time and stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping.
- footage shall be provided free of charge to Police or authorised council officer within 24 hours of a request.
- a staff member from the premises that is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times. This staff member will be able to show police or authorised officers of the Licensing Authority recent data footage with the minimum of delay when requested. This data or footage reproduction shall be almost instantaneous

2. A daily incident log shall be kept at the Premises and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Council or the Police or the Fire Service which shall record the following:

- (a) all crimes reported to the venue
- (b) all ejection of patrons
- (c) any complaints received
- (d) any incidents of disorder
- (e) any incidents of disorder
- (f) any faults in the CCTV system

3. Deliveries shall be made to bona fide business or residential addresses only.

4. There shall be no members of the public permitted on the premises after 00:00hrs Monday to Thursday where late night refreshment shall be supplied by delivery only thereafter.

5. There shall be no members of the public permitted on the premises after 01:00hrs on Friday and Saturday where late night refreshment shall be supplied by delivery only thereafter.

6. Delivery riders are to wait inside the premises in between collecting deliveries.

7. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits used by delivery drivers requesting them to respect the needs of local residents and leave the area quietly.

8. A notice shall be displayed by the front door stating the restaurant opening hours and that all orders after 00:00hrs Sunday - Thursday and 01:00 Friday - Saturday must be phoned through and are by home delivery only
