Comments: 22/02/2024 4:03 PM I object to the sale of alcohol after 2200 on Sundays and 2300 during the week because of the external terrace at 4th floor level which will carry sound a long way and thus create a public nuisance. The application is inconsistent with the location of the premises in quiet residential area bordered by a family park, a dense housing estate and with a frontage along the River Thames which will amplify the sound. No measures are proposed to limit sound from the premises. The applicant has not provided a local area risk assessment, thus breaching Policy 1 of LBHF's Licensing Policy. Insufficient consideration has been given to Policy 11, consideration of residents, especially users of Bishops Park and the River Gardens flats.

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
