MEMBERSHIP AND TERMS OF REFERENCE-APPOINTMENT OF CO-OPTED MEMBER

This report outlines an additional recommendation regarding the appointment of a non-voting co-opted member to the Committee.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Committee is asked to confirm the appointment of Eugenie White as a non-voting co-opted member.

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The Terms of Reference for the Audit and Pensions Committee, under 1.3, state that "The Committee may co-opt non-voting independent members as appropriate."
- 1.2 Eugenie White is a former Councillor on the Hammersmith and Fulham Council, and a former member of the Council's Pension Fund Panel. The Committee has now absorbed the duties of the Pension Fund Panel.
- 1.3 It is proposed that, given the high level of Eugenie White's contribution to the Pension Fund Panel, she be co-opted to the new Audit and Pensions Committee as a non-voting independent member.

2. COMMENTS OF THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND CORPORATE SERVICES

Under the Council's Members Allowances Scheme, co-opted members and independent members of the Standards Committee are entitled to an annual allowance of £921.
