**1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 1.1 This report records the Cabinet Member’s decision to appoint LA Governors which falls within the scope of her executive portfolio.

That Mr Charles Napier be appointed as LA Governor for Brackenbury Primary School for a four year term with effect from date of signature.

**3. REASONS FOR DECISION**

- 3.1 The Cabinet Member gives the following reasons for the following appointments:

Mr Charlie Napier has lived in the Brook Green/Shepherds Bush area for the last 15 years. For eight of those years he was a LA Governor (3 years as Vice Chair) at Peterborough Primary School and four years at Fulham Primary. He was also a Councillor in Fulham Broadway from 2002-06. He runs his own consultancy firm based in Hammersmith. Based on his professional experience and contributions to the education and wellbeing of children in other schools in the Borough, he would make a positive contribution to the work of the Governing Body of Brackenbury Primary School, and should therefore be appointed.
