<p>FIRE SAFETY & ACCELERATION PROGRAMME DISABLED CHILDREN'S RESOURCE CENTRE AND RE-BUILD OF SEN UNIT AT THE QUEEN'S MANOR SCHOOL SITE</p> <p>In line with the Council's commitment to Fire Safety and to ensure its properties meet higher standards this report proposes to incorporate a fire sprinkler system in to the new disabled children's resource centre and SEN unit at Queen's Manor primary school.</p> <p>The excavation of Saxon remains has led to a four-week delay of the project whilst further archaeological work was undertaken. It is proposed to implement a programme of works to enable the centre to be operational for the 2018 Easter school holiday.</p> <p><u>Reasons for Urgency:</u></p> <p>The contractors are on site and there is a need to vary the contract to accommodate the additional works.</p> <p>Ward: Palace Riverside</p> <p><u>Agreed:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
